RECEIPT OF BIDS: Sealed bids will be received at the Washington Terrace City Offices, 5249 S. South Pointe Drive, Washington Terrace City, Utah, until 2:00 pm on September 10, 2015 for the VICTORY PARK BOWERY PROJECT.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The work consists of furnishing and constructing a Bowery Structure and associated appurtenances at Victory Park in Washington Terrace City that meets the specifications provided in the request for bids.

LOCATION OF THE WORK: The work is located at Victory Park in Washington Terrace City, Utah (approximately 275 East 4425 South).

COMPLETION OF THE WORK: All project work shall be completed on or before November 30, 2015.

OPENING OF BIDS: The bids will be publicly opened at 2:00 pm on September 10, 2015 at the above mentioned Washington Terrace City Offices, 5249 S. South Pointe Drive, Washington Terrace City, Utah.

BID SECURITY: Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price payable to WASHINGTON TERRACE CITY CORPORATION as a guarantee that the bidder, if his bid is accepted, will promptly execute the Contract, secure payment of worker's compensation insurance and furnish a satisfactory, faithful performance bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price and a payment bond in the amount of one hundred (100%) of the contract price.

WAITING PERIOD BEFORE AWARD: A waiting period of 30 calendar days from the date of opening of bids to the award of contract may be required. Bidders shall assume full responsibility for and shall guarantee the bid price during this period.
