

The Utah Department of Water Quality (DWQ) requires cities to provide adequate water pressure and fire flow capacity and volume throughout the city. Washington Terrace City is separated into 4 zones: A, B, C, & D. Each zone is run independently to ensure they met the DWQ requirements. Zones C and D are currently linked together.

Washington Terrace City will be installing a distribution water line along 500 West between 5100 South and 4800 South this fall to separate zones C and D. The water tank on 500 west will also be refurbished and used to supply the water volume for zone D.

The project consists of installing and connecting a 10" PVC water main. This is solely a distribution line. Residents in the area will not be connected to the new line. Construction will require sections of 500 West to be temporarily closed during the day. Proper signage and detours will be required by the contractor. Residents in the area of a road closure will be notified prior to construction. This project is scheduled to **start October 26th 2020.**

This is a Washington Terrace City Capital Project. The City has received funding from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to assist with funding.
