

Frequently Asked Questions

I don't know who is on my ballot and I don't know where to find information about the issues and candidates.

As the date of the Election approaches, there will be numerous places for you to view a sample ballot, read candidate biographies, and research the issues. The State of Utah has created personalized information for each voter at www.vote.utah.gov. At that website, each voter may enter their address to view a sample ballot, read candidate bios, locate their polling place and much, much more.

I don't trust Voting by Mail – can't anyone sign my ballot?

Weber County Elections and the State of Utah have developed stringent guidelines to verify the signatures on each ballot received. When the ballot first arrives in the Elections office, it is compared to the signature on file from your voter registration form. After the initial review, if the signature does not match, additional team members will review it. If any question still remains as to the legitimacy of the signature, then we make every effort to contact that voter in order to allow them to verify their signature.

How do I know that my Vote by Mail ballot was received and counted?

Once the ballots are mailed out, approximately three weeks prior to Election Day, any voter may log onto www.vote.utah.gov to track the status of their ballot. Voters may also call the Elections Office at (801) 399-8034.
