Notice is hereby given that the Washington Terrace City Council will hold a public hearing at City Hall located at 5249 South 400 East, Washington Terrace City, Utah, on May 19, 2020, at 6:00 pm to receive and consider public comment on the City's practice of continuing to not charging itself for utility services (culinary water, sanitary sewer, storm water, and refuse) used in delivering City operated services. The estimated dollar amounts for fiscal year 2021 of the non-charged utility services and the percentage of total fund expenses for which they represent are as follows: culinary water fund up to \$65,353 or 3%; sanitary sewer fund up to \$1,721 or 0.1%; storm water fund up to \$19,211 or 3%; and refuse fund up to \$3,887 or 0.6%. All interested utility customers are invited to attend and offer comment.

Note: Due to the Governor's directive not to congregate, City Council meetings will be held via Zoom and live-streamed on the City's Facebook page (Washington Terrace City). Comments will be addressed through live Facebook postings during the Public Hearing.

The estimated dollar amounts for fiscal year 2021 of the non-charged utility services and the percentage of total fund expenses for which they represent are as follows: culinary water fund up to \$65,353 or 4%; sanitary sewer fund up to \$1,721 or 0.1%; storm water fund up to \$19,211 or 3.6%; and refuse fund up to \$3,887 or 0.7%.
