



2019 By Mail Elections

Your municipal election will be conducted mainly **By Mail**. On average 90% – 95% of all votes cast are cast by mail. All active, registered voters are mailed a ballot **3 weeks prior to Election Day**. Voters who have moved must update their registration address by the registration deadline to receive a by mail ballot.

Ballots will not be forwarded by the Postal Service.

By Mail ballots may be returned two ways;

Post Office (postage is required)	Must be postmarked no later than the day before Election Day .
Ballot Drop Box (No postage required)	Secure, outside and available 24hrs/day. All drop boxes close promptly at 8:00pm on Election Day .

*** Drop Boxes are located at all City Hall's, all County Libraries and on campus at Weber State University.** (An *indoor* drop box is available at The Weber Center during normal business hours. An *indoor* drop box will be available on Election Day at the Weber County Fairs Grounds Vote Center).

Voters, who do not receive a ballot in the mail or do not register to vote prior to the deadline, may vote in person at **any** Vote Center location. **ID is required**.

Early Voting <i>General Election</i>	Oct. 30th, 31st, Nov 1st, 4th 8:00am – 5:00pm	The Weber Center 2380 Washington Blvd
Election Day <i>General Election</i>	November 5th 7:00am – 8:00pm	All County Libraries & the County Fair Grounds

* Depending on which cities require a Primary Election, all Vote Centers may not be utilized on **Primary Election Day**. All Primary Candidates will be notified once the candidate filing period has concluded.
